The Flamingo Pool, a self-funded charity has recently installed an Aquagym, open to the public, and launched its 'Aquatherapy' GP referral scheme. It was the first in the country to open a hydrotherapy pool to the public.

Both pools are disinfected by Ultra-Violet (UV) light so that the level of chlorine in the pools is approximately a third of a normally disinfected pool.

Anyone can come to the Flamingo Pool for swimming, Aquafit, Aquagym, Aquatherapy, swimming lessons, lifesaving, swimming clubs, family fun, inflatable sessions and training courses.
